CAUV/AG DISTRICT PROGRAM

We have enrolled our front 38 acres in the CAUV and AG District programs. Current Agricultural Use Value (CAUV) is a differential real estate tax assessment program which affords owners of farmland the opportunity to have their parcels taxed according to their value in agriculture, rather than full market value. To qualify for use value assessment, a landowner must devote the parcel "exclusively to agricultural use," as stated in Section 5713.30 of the Ohio Revised Code. Enrolling in the AG District program is a commitment to continue using the land for farming. Benefits include:

- Defer sewer, water or electric assessments as long as land is farmed.
- Legal protection for any generally accepted agricultural practice in the defense of a nuisance lawsuit made against the farming operation.
- Limited protection against the use of eminent domain.

A special thanks goes out to Rich Moretti for his help with getting ARGC qualified for this program.
