By Laws - Proposed Change

It is proposed to change Article VI: *Qualification of Members*, paragraph 6 to read:

"All members who have a Senior Membership prior to April 10, 2010 shall be grandfathered and not subject to change. After April 10, 2010 by application to the Secretary any member who has been a member in good standing for at least 5 years and is age 65 or older will be granted a Senior Citizen Membership at one half of working dues rate.
