By Laws - Proposed Change

It is proposed to change Article VI: *Qualification of Members*, paragraph 6 to read:

"All members who have a Senior Membership prior to April 10, 2010 shall be grandfathered and not subject to change. After April 10, 2010 by application to the Secretary any member who has been a member in good standing for at least 5 years and is age 65 or older will be granted a Senior Citizen Membership at one half of working dues rate. He or she will not be subject to work time. Senior Citizen membership shall have full rights and privileges of membership." This proposal will be brought forth to the membership for vote at the April 1st monthly membership meeting.

After considerable discussion, the membership approved this By-Law Change with a 36 to 27 count.
