## **LETTER TO MEMBERS**

To Ashtabula Rod and Gun Club Members,

Rifle shooting is the only recreation I have. I don't play golf, bingo, or visit gambling casinos.

It's my belief that there isn't a nicer facility in the immediate area. People have to drive long distances to get to a club this nice. Shooters from the Cleveland area have to drive out to R&GC because their clubs have been shut down.

While I'm not wealthy, I certainly can afford fifty dollars a year to help keep a place for me to shoot.

I understand further that we have 97 seniors, including myself, who do not have to pay dues. I don't see how a club can be sustained with this many non-dues paying members.

We seniors were promised that after five years membership and sixty five years of age, we would no longer have to pay dues, or give work hours. However, with housing development all around the area, we seniors need to contribute our share. If not, very soon, AR&GC will no longer be a shooting club.

In my humble opinion, members who have said they will drop out over the fifty dollar land assessment, are not thinking clearly, to let a club like the Ashtabula Rod & Gun Club disappear over fifty dollars a year.

It's hard to believe that people who drive big expensive trucks, SUV's and own and shoot very expensive guns and ammunition could begrudge fifty dollars a year to keep our club in present form.

Most of us have been in this club for many years, now you want to throw it all away for \$50.00 a year.

Without the support of everybody, this club will no longer exist.
