ARGC GAS & OIL LEASE OPPORTUNITY

Ashtabula County is in the beginning stages of a large gas and oil boom. Land speculators and drilling companies are attempting to get large blocks of land under their control. Terry Berkey has researched the opportunity for ARGC and has talked to the following companies:

- NELA (Northcoast Envr. Landowners Assoc.)
- Wishgard LLC
- Gas Lease Professional LLC

The listed companies have different lease terms and payments for gas drilling rights. Maximum income (\$2500 to \$4500 per acre) would be for an evasive (Drilling on property) lease but take 5 to 8 years to receive or we can enter into a non-evasive lease agreement with payment (\$1280 per acre) received in 6 to 9 months. This would provide our land fund with (98 acres times \$1280) \$125,440 taxable income. This would allow quick repayment of our land debt and eliminate the current need for land assessments. This was discussed with members in attendance at our May membership meeting. We will ask members to approve the non-evasive faster payment option at the June membership meeting.
