NEWSLETTER MAILING

The Finance Committee Chairman, John Kucera advised membership that it is currently costing the club \$2200 - \$2500 per year to mail a paper copy of the newsletter to each member. This money can be saved by e-mailing copies of the newsletter to our members. This change would go into effect with the January 2013 newsletter. This would give members sufficient time to submit their email address. This cost saving initiative was approved by the ARGC membership at the October meeting.

SENIOR MEMBERSHIP - BY LAWS CHANGE

ARGC's current by-laws provides for a Senior Membership benefit for all members in good standing for 5 years and have reached the age of 65. The Senior benefit provides the qualifying Senior member with full rights and privileges of membership at a reduced working member annual dues rate and removes the work time requirement. The Finance Committee has proposed to remove the Senior Membership Category from our by-laws. This would apply to all new members submitting their application the month following approval of this change. All current ARGC members in good standing and new members submitting applications prior to the membership approval of this change would be grandfathered and this change would not apply to them. Membership approved this By Laws change with an effective date of January 1, 2013.
