ODNR

Jason Hadsell, our district ODNR officer attended our February meeting to provide members with a current update and answer questions. Jason advised:

- "Hunting without Permission" is the major complaint received. You must have written permission to hunt on someone else's property. Complaints will be Enforced. Penalty for 1st. Offense is \$200 fine.
- The Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) will seek public comments regarding the 2013-2014 hunting seasons. During these sessions, which will be held Saturday, March 2, from 12-3 p.m., input concerning proposed hunting season dates, bag limits and rule changes will be accepted. Wildlife District Three office is located at 912 Portage Lakes Drive, Akron 44319, 330-644-2293
- The proposed Game Check system will make it easier, licenses will all be of white paper, not perforated. Temporary tags made by the hunter can be put on the animal. You will be able to check in over the phone.
- The proposal for Free Sr. Hunting licenses could result in a significant loss of funding if approved. Funding amount is determined by the number hunting licenses sold. This could cause a 10% decrease to the annual ODNR budget.
