#### **OUTDOOR WEEKEND**

The Outdoor Weekend will be held in July from Friday July 12th through Sunday July 14th.

*"ALL RANGES WILL BE CLOSED"* Outdoor Weekend is an activity for boys and girls ages 11 to 16. This event is a hands on weekend learning experience. Participants learn how to shoot black powder muzzleloaders, .22 rifle, trap, skeet, and archery. For children safety, shooting events are one on one with an instructor. Ear plugs and safety glasses are furnished. Hunters education topics will include hunter safety, bow hunting, survival, trap & field care, turkey hunting, and much more fun.

Tents are set up for sleeping and food is furnished. This event begins Friday evening at 6:00PM and ends

Sunday afternoon. Sunday's activities will conclude with a test, that if passed, will allow participants to get their hunting license.

If your child has previously attended a hunter safety class ( recommended ) he or she can still attend this event. Participants need to bring a sleeping bag, flashlight, and their personal items.

This event is open to the public, however **<u>attendance is</u> <u>by advance registration only</u>**. Application forms, medical report (if taking medicine), and parental consent forms are to be completed and returned to Skip Craine by July 5, 2013.
