#### **DUES AND ASSESSMENT PAYMENTS**

It was announced at the April membership meeting that the following payment structure will be in effect for the 2016 membership year:

#### **LAND ASSESSMENT**

There was no vote at this time, but a discussion of land assessment and keeping ARGC's land fund healthy was held by the Board:

- All members continue to pay \$50.00 land assessment until enough monies are in said fund to pay off the 2011 purchase of the Ryder property.
- Land assessment money will continue to be collected from new members joining after the initial land assessment stops. This allows the land fund to continue to grow.
- All new members will be responsible for paying the same amount per year until they reach the equal amount from the land assessment purchase (5 10 years).

(example: A member in 2011 has paid land assessment of \$50.00 per year for 8 years. A member joining in 2015 will be required to pay land assessment for 8 years and so on.)

• All monies collected for the land assessments are to be strictly used for land purchase only, unless mitigating circumstances arise. The Board then must present its case before the membership for a vote.
