- AEP lands located in central and southern Ohio are being sold. Land that was open for hunting may now be closed. Check to see if it is still open before you make the drive south!
- A study is being conducted on State turkey population. It is believed that turkeys in NE Ohio nest about 2 weeks later than other locations. If this is confirmed, Hunting seasons in NE Ohio could be adjusted by the Spring of 2018.
- Antlerless deer permits will not be valid in Ashtabula County this year.
