#### ODNR

ODNR Officer Jason Warren stopped by our meeting to give members the following updates and answer any questions:

- There is no major change to hunting season this year. The deer bonus days will be held the weekend before Christmas
- 44% of last years deer harvest was by archery. 10 years ago, the percentage was 25% by archery.
- Deer population is up 5 to 10%.
- The turkey population is forecasted up, especially in the areas where the cicadas are prevalent.
- Future looks good for lake walleye fishing. The perch population is down. Believed to be caused by the recent extreme cold winters.
- The absence of the milkweed plant is believed to be the leading cause of the Monarch butterfly decline. There is a statewide initiative to conserve and replenish.

#### LAND ASSESSMENT

The Board approved capping the land assessment payment at \$250 per member. For members that began paying the \$50 per year assessment in 2011 and continued through 2016, the assessment ends this year. All members current and future are required to pay the \$250 land assessment. It can be paid at \$50 per year or a lump sum payment.
