#### **VERIZON TOWER**

President, Gib Ingwer advised membership that voting on acceptance or rejection of the American Tower proposal would take place at the December membership meeting. Greg Keefer reminded that membership has not seen a complete proposal contract due to the missing Exhibits A, C, and D and that a motion was made and passed by membership in October requesting an updated and **complete contract** to review prior to voting . Secretary Dawn Johnston will attempt to obtain the missing exhibits for e-mailing to members prior to the December meeting.

Mark Hepler presented the following comments after his review of the American Tower Proposal:

- 1. I did not see any provisions for them maintaining our property in 'Like or better condition' when they access the easement, which includes not only the 10,000 Square ft fenced enclosure but the Utility Easement from Ninevah road back to the Tower easement. I didn't see any provisions for repairing damage to our roads that may be caused by Heavy equipment used to maintain their utility and property easement. We already had the incident with the Culvert caving in after Verizon did the initial work.
- 2. There was also a provision for not only ATC Sequoia, but any and all current (Verizon) and future tenants on the tower to have 24x7 access to the property and never be blocked from maintaining their equipment. We can't seem to get the gate combination to the ONE Verizon guy each year when we change it. (I get an email from him every year when it changes, and he can't get in because he wasn't notified by the board) Not sure how we would manage multiple tenants access.

"PUT HUT DUCK BLIND"

- The Put Hut has a powder coated steel rod frame which is wrapped with 600 cordura fabric
- It's equipped with foam floats on the bottom
- The Put Hut weighs 8.5 pounds and comes with a shoulder rig.
- The blind is effective in a water depth from 1" to 3". Adjustable legs allow you to set the blind up on dry land or in water. The legs also allow you to put more weight on the blind and help stabilize in high winds...includes 4 adjustable legs, PVC stand "Brush Blind"
- The Put Hut is 38" tall and the bottom is 46" on the inside. At the lid, the blind is 36" wide.
- Two pins hold the lid to the bottom. Simply slide two pins and snap them
  down on the side panel to help the blind hold its shape and support the
  lid.
- The lid is spring loaded with a bungee cord. Just hook one end to the roof and the other to the back panel.
- To hunt, pull the lid down, hook the roof latch and when you are ready to shoot just flip the latch to take 'em! Rectangular notches on each slide allow right and left handed shooters to utilize the blind. Most guns are going to have around 16" of barrel sticking out of the blind


