Article VI: Qualifications of Members

Section VI

66

All members who have a Senior Membership prior to April 10, 2010 shall be grandfathered and not subject to change. After April 10, 2010 by application to the Secretary any member who has been a member in good standing for at least 5 continuous years and is age 65 or older will be granted a Senior Citizen Membership at one half of working dues rate. He or she will not be subject to work time. Senior Citizen membership shall have full rights and privileges of membership. By application to the Secretary starting January 1, 2013 new members will no longer receive Senior Membership status. Members joining prior to January 1, 2013 in good standing and having 5 continuous years and is age 65 or older will be granted a Senior Citizen Membership at one half of working dues rate. He or she will not be subject to work time.

Article VI: Qualifications of Members

Section VI

All members who have a Senior Membership prior to April 10, 2010 shall be grandfathered and not subject to change. After April 10, 2010 by application to the Secretary any member who has been a member in good standing for at least 5 continuous years and is age 65 or older will be granted a <u>Senior 2</u> Membership at one half of working dues rate. He or she will not be subject to work time. <u>Senior 2</u> membership shall have full rights and privileges of membership. <u>Members who have achieved 25 years of ARGC membership, and are 65 years or older, and is a member in good standing will be granted Senior Membership Status, will not be required to any work time nor pay any yearly dues. All members who have achieved 25 years of membership on or before January 1, 2018 will be grandfathered in. It is the responsibility of the secretary to maintain records of members entry date and birthday. EXCEPTION to this rule will be when an assessment is applied to all members.

Members joining after to January 1, 2013 in good standing and having 5 continuous years and is age 65 or older will be granted a <u>Senior 2</u> Membership at one half of working dues rate. He or she will not be subject to work time.</u>


