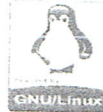

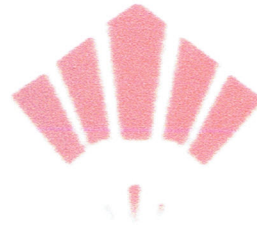

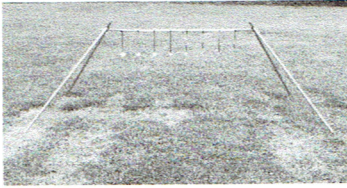

Ashtabula Rod and Gun Club

Sunday, 10/28 - KYL (Know Your Limits)

Eight round hanging steel targets ranging in diameter from 2" down to 1/4" shot at 50 yards from a bench or prone. Front bipod and/or bag and a rear bag may be used.

Match: Sign-up and sight-in 9:00 AM. Match starts at 10:00 AM.

- Range Fee for all KYL rounds – **No Charge for 10/28/18 Introductory Match**
- Shoot the Match for bragging rights or.... enter the \$5.00 Match:
 - Three rounds per shooter per match
 - All match money paid out to top 3 places (50/30/20) < Ten \$5.00 competitors
 - All match money paid out to top 4 places (50/25/15/10) > Ten \$5.00 competitors
 - Target point assignment: 2-2-3-4-6-8-10-15=50
 - Acquire and bank points for each hit target. A miss or out of order hit loses all points for the round.

Rules:

- Shooting position from bench or prone. Eye and ear protection required.
- 50-yard targets
- 8 shots in a 2-minute round
- Visible target movement must be evident to score a hit. A high arm hit is a miss. The Scorer's decision is final. All contestants are urged to participate in scoring.
- No rifle or scope restrictions. 22 LR only.
- Front bipod and/or bag and rear bag are allowed
- No adjustable or one-piece rests. No lead sleds.
- No rear monopods
- No tripod configuration fixtures
- No mechanical rear support devices
- .22 LR Standard Velocity ammo is recommended. 1300 FPS is the maximum velocity ammo allowed. No Stingers, Magnums, or .17 caliber.
- Ties will be broken by a shoot off using the smallest target scored
- An Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) must be installed when not at the bench.

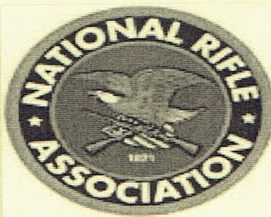
