CONCEALED CARRY COURSE

A CCW course will be offered by one of our members, Daryl Upole, at the Club. Mark Hepler, another Club member, is also one of the Instructors. Our last class was a huge success and resulted in six new member applications! The course will be offered at the end of January, 2015: It will be Friday, January 23 5PM-9PM, Saturday, January 24 from 10AM-4PM and Sunday, January 25 10AM-3PM.

The pistol range will be closed for the course on Sunday, January 25, 2015 from 10AM-2PM.

This course exceeds the 12-hour Ohio CCW requirements with over 15 hours of training and includes extended range time. All students are welcome, but the emphasis of this course and its design is for newer and less experienced students. Students may gain experience with multiple firearms. Students are welcome to bring their own firearms. This is a basic, slow-paced course to allow those who are new to firearms to become comfortable with them. This course will be a comfortable, relaxed, safe environment for these students. We feature a guest speaker on extended legal issues. This is an ideal course for Members to send their friends and family to – they will not be disappointed.

The cost is \$249 per person. This cost includes EVERYTHING needed from pens, paper, firearms, ammunition, safety equipment, refreshments, food, and snacks. It also includes a custom-built Kydex holster for your firearm from Blue Line Holsters. This is a quality holster. There is a \$50 merchandise credit (ammo, firearms, and accessories) to ANY ARGC member or members of their immediate household. In addition, any paid registration prior to December 24, 2014 for two students at the same time receives an up-front \$100 discount plus you still get the ARGC member merchandise credit for both students (\$50 each).
